2. ISSS Faculty Search Presentation (Elizabeth Barnum, Director, ISSS)

- ISSS (International Student and Scholar Services): deals with issues related to immigration and the hiring of foreign nationals
- PERM: government process that allows faculty/instructors to get a green card
- Departments should meet with ISSS before a search begins
- PERM/hiring of non-U.S. citizens requires a competitive recruitment and selection process (national search posted on MLA JIL) and careful documentation by the search committee, showing that non-U.S. candidate is the most qualified

3. Presentation of Outcomes Assessment Report (Richard Vernon):

- Results of the Outcomes Assessment plan implemented for the last 3 years were discussed
